

- Engage citizens for constructive input




General Planning Process Flow


ASSESS current conditions and needs PROJECT future demands and improvements ALLOCATE resources and prioritize projects

Managing the Existing System + Accommodating a Growing Population

- About 2,500 additional residents are projected to live in Penn Township between 2010-2040 in approximately 977 new housing units.
- Assuming 80% of the new units are built in the Township's Growth Area, 195 will be scattered in the
 rural areas while 782 will be located to the south and east of Manheim Borough where public
 infrastructure is.
- Increased traffic from new housing = approx. 9,200 more trips by 2040 (assuming current behavior).
